

Are You Listening For The Savior's Call?

There is a beautiful old hymn by V.O. Stamps that boldly states:

When the Savior calls I will answer, When He calls for me I will hear; When the Savior calls I will answer, I'll be somewhere listening for my name.

The words of this beautiful old hymn reminds us of Job's plight because they are so similar to Job's answer to the age-old question, "If a man die, shall he live again?" (Job14:14). Job is a man who understood life and the "after-life." He knew, with out a doubt, that the grave is only a place for the righteous to rest until the great resurrection. Jesus informs us that "the hour is coming in which all who are in the graves will hear His voice and come forth; Those who have done good to the resurrection of life, and those who have done evil, to the resurrection of condemnation" (John 5:28-29).

The writer of Hebrews encourages us by stating "there remains a rest for the people of God." And the faithful child of God enters into that rest after death (Hebrews 4:9-10). And Luke alludes to this rest in the story Jesus told of a man named Lazarus who, upon his death, 'was carried by the angels into Abraham's bosom" (Luke 16:20, cf.vss. 19-31). Every indication of this beautiful story is that paradise is that place of rest where one awaits the resurrection. John also wrote of that rest after death: 'Then I heard a voice from heaven saying to me, Write, Blessed are the dead who die in the Lord from now on: Yes, says the Spirit, that they may rest from their labors; and their works do follow them" (Revelation 14:13). Job, in his understanding of a rest and life after this life, said, "all the days of my hard service I will wait, till my change come. You shall call, and I will answer You" (Job 14:14b-15a). This is as it shall be for all the faithful of the ages, And,

> If my heart is right when He calls me, If my heart is right I will hear; If my heart is right when He calls me, I'll be somewhere listening for my name. If my robe is white when He calls me, If my robe is white I will hear; If my robe is white when He calls me, I'll be somewhere listening for my name.

All will hear their name called when Jesus returns, but only the faithful will actually be listening for His call. "Behold, I tell you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed, in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet: for the trumpet will sound and the dead will be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed" (1 Corinthians 15:51-52). Like righteous Job, as we wait for that time when we shall be changed, let us give thanks unto God "who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ" (1 Corinthians 15:57)
