Is Your Faith Grounded In God-Given Biblical Authority?

In Mark 11:28 the authority of Jesus was questioned by the chief priests and elders: “*And they said to Him, By what authority are you doing these things, and who gave you this authority?*” As we look into the things taught and practiced in religion today we must ask the same question. Saving “*faith comes by hearing the word of God*” (Romans 10:17). Are the following doctrines taught by God or are they a part of the commandments of men of which Jesus spoke in Matthew 15:8-9? In our Wednesday Bible class we have been studying some popular doctrines taught about little babies. See if your belief in these doctrines corresponds with the Bible.

- **INHERITING THE GUILT OF SIN:** God says, “*The soul that sins shall die. The son shall not bear the guilt of the father, nor the father bear the guilt of the son. The righteousness of the righteous shall be upon himself, and the wickedness of the wicked shall be upon himself*” (Ezekiel 18:20). Since infants are incapable of committing sins and do not bear the guilt of the father’s sin, how can it be said that babies inherit the guilt of sin?
- **BAPTIZING INFANTS:** Jesus says, “*He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned*” (Mark 16:16). Belief in Jesus Christ is not something one is born with, it must be taught the individual when he/she reaches an age wherein they can understand. Therefore infants are not proper subjects for baptism. Further, as one reads Scripture he finds that when baptism is administered it was to men and women (Acts 2:41; Acts 8:12).
- **SPRIKLING or POURING FOR BAPTISM:** The Holy Spirit inspired writer said, “*Therefore we are buried with Him (Jesus) through baptism into death, that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life*” (Romans 6:4). I have officiated at well over a hundred funerals, yet I have never seen a dead body laid out on the ground with a little dirt sprinkled or poured upon it and it be called a burial. Should one try to do so he would be in violation of several laws of the land. To be buried is to be completely covered by that in which one is buried, be it in the ground, entombed in a concrete sepulcher or cave with the door sealed (as was Jesus), or buried at sea. It is a complete submersion. The baptism which Jesus and His apostles taught and practiced was and is completely immersing the subject in water.
- **SALVATION BEFORE ONE IS BAPTIZED:** Again Jesus said; “*He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned*” (Mark 16:16). Jesus here says it takes both belief and baptism to produce salvation. The reason being, we meet Jesus in His death when we are “*buried with Him through baptism*” (Romans 6:3-4). Infants are born in a “safe state” and are not guilty of sin until they reach the age of knowing good and evil. Upon reaching that age one cannot be saved before the blood of Christ washes their sins away. Through the example of Saul of Tarsus we are taught that in baptism one’s sins are washed away (Acts 22:16). In Bible times, “those who gladly received His word were baptized” (Acts 2:41). It is at that point that the Lord adds the saved to His church (Acts 2:47).
