## Well, Church, Say Your Prayers

Tempers have flared, accusations have flown, name-calling has been rampant, rumors and lies have been flying around like crazy. And unfortunately, this doesn't just describe the people in the world--it includes some people in the church. But now the election is over. The votes have been cast, and Donald Trump has taken the Electoral College. But a lot of people are not very happy with it. That includes some Christians.

What we do know for certain is that God's word stands true, and His commands still apply to us today, just as much as they did when Nero was the emperor of Rome. And God says that we are to pray. *"Therefore, I exhort that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks be made for all men: for Kings and **all that are in authority**; so that we might lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty. For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Savior."* (1 Timothy 2:1-2).

Whether you like the outcome of the election or not, pray for our next President. That doesn't mean you are in agreement with him on certain policies or behavior (or anything, for that matter), but you pray nonetheless.

This is *"good and acceptable"* before God. I hope you understand that to not pray for the next President is therefore not good and acceptable before God--it is bad and unacceptable before God.

Please stop and take a moment to seriously consider what God asks of us in that passage, and then say a prayer for our future president, and also for our current one. It's the right thing to do.

In my travels as a gospel preacher I have had opportunities to see and hear many announcements of prayer requests. In many small congregations names were written on a chalk board in front of the auditorium and then each person on the list would be mentioned with their present condition. In one large congregation names were flashed on the large video screen. At the East Denver church of Christ, an African American congregation, one of the elders stood before us and talked lovingly about each person on their prayer list, and prayed for each one individually. His announcements lasted about forty minutes. In his voice he brought to life First Corinthians 12:26-27: *"And whether one member suffer, all the members suffer with it; or if one member be honored, all the members rejoice with it. Now ye are the body of Christ, and members in particular."* (KJV).

We are so blessed in that our Spiritual Father has given us this line of communication by which we may *"come boldly to His throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace and help in time of need"* (Hebrews 4:16).

It is for this very reason that we keep the full prayer list in this paper each week. As you pray for each one, and as Brother Cobb suggests in the above article, for *"all that are in authority"* it will be the most important communication you will have today.
