## WHAT WOULD IT TAKE?

There can be no doubt that we are now living in very perilous times. We see riots and carnage within our very neighborhoods throughout the land. Human life is no more precious to many than that of an animal. Innocent people, and even little children are murdered for no reason other than the thrill of it. Christian beliefs and morals are looked upon as hateful teachings and actions. What would it take for our nation to rid itself of all this evil which is cast upon us? Would that our elected leaders would open their eyes and hearts to the only answer-Jesus Christ. In the very ancient past Solomon stated, *“Righteousness exalts a nation, but sin is a reproach to any people”* (Proverbs 14:34). Knowing this fact, it grieves us to know that our nation, as well as most around this world is led by godless individuals who refuse to even consider that the God of heaven and earth will punish all who reproach Him by leading away from Christian principles.

It is so refreshing to hear of any soul responding to the gospel message, but the rarity of a government official raises our hopes to higher levels. Following is an excerpt from the latest report from Adam Evans, our missionary in Tanzania, Africa.

### New Church Plant in Tukuyu

Great news!!! A government official in Tukuyu (Mbeya Region) recently received the “Church of the Bible” book that we had just translated, printed, and distributed. He contacted Bright requesting baptism. Bright traveled to Tukuyu. He met with Israel (former translator for John Strong). Lubange (a preacher from Chimala originally from Tukuyu), Joseph Hange of Chimala, and Imma Burton (a 2015 graduate from Andrew Connally School of PreachingSOP from Kyela) to evangelize and then baptize those interested. I am happy to say that 9 souls were baptized! To God be the glory.

The Chimala preacher Lubange, Imma Burton, and others have been sowing the seed in Tukuyu. We have now watered and God has brought the increase. Great things happen when we collaborate in the work of the Kingdom. Due to the interest in the “Church of the Bible” material, one government official named Mwasakilali (who is over Tukuyu District) was ready to obey the gospel and be added to the body of Christ. This man then reached out to others to hear the saving message and they all responded Sunday morning before worship. They then all gathered together for their first worship service in Tukuyu. Tukuyu is presently about 7 hours from here (9 hours by bus). This is a new church plant. To our knowledge, there has never been a congregation there in town. Now the church has been planted!!! Praise God.

### Read all of Adam’s report on the big board in back of the auditorium.

Although our world is struggling, and it seems that things just get worse and worse, there are exciting things happening in the Lord’s church around the world. As long as we continue to preach Christ’s gospel-unadulterated-we will continue to see precious souls saved. Thank God for the ability we have to assist those preaching that message.
