THE NAMES THAT WE WEAR

Is God pleased with just any name we choose to wear in religion? Many today think it makes no difference as long as we are sincere in our chosen faith. However, when we turn to the inspired Word of God we find it far different than the modern-day beliefs of most people. God was very displeased with the church at Corinth because the people began to divide into splinter groups much as we see today in the many different denominations who believe Jesus to be the Christ. Inspired of God, the apostle Paul wrote to them, rebuking them for dividing in this way: *"Now I plead with you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that you all speak the same thing, and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment"* (1 Corinthians 1:10).

Their sin was not in disbelieving Jesus of Nazareth to be the Christ, it was in wearing names of mere men instead of the name of Christ. Some were saying, *"I am of Paul."* Others said they were of Apollos, and still others claimed to be of Cephas (Peter). These were three of the greatest evangelists who ever lived to bless the Lord's church, but they were not to be followed by men wearing their names. Neither of them was crucified for us, neither were we baptized into a name other than Christ's name. Thus to wear a name other than His name is to divide Christ. What believers today seem not to realize is that it is as much a sin today to wear other names as it was for the Corinthians to do so 2,000 years ago.

In 1 Corinthians 11:1 Paul wrote *"Be ye followers of me, even as I also am of Christ."* (KJV). We love Paul, as well as Apollos and Peter, because they were faithfully preaching the glorious gospel of Jesus Christ. Their leadership can be trusted for the simple reason that they were following in the footsteps of Christ (cf. 1 Peter 2:21; 1 Corinthians 3:6). Although Paul taught that baptism is where we are *"baptized into Christ Jesus baptized into His death...That just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life"* (Romans 6:3-4), Paul was thankful that he had not personally baptized many of the Corinthians lest they say he baptized in his own name (1 Corinthians 1:15-16). Apparently he allowed his coworkers such as Silas and Timothy to do the actual baptizing. As such he was again following the example of Christ (cf. John 4:1-2). And, again, those baptized by those early evangelists wore only the name of Christ.

The wearing of Christ's name was a major point in the prophecies of Old. *"The Gentiles shall see your righteousness, and all kings your glory. You shall be called by a new name, which the mouth of the Lord will name."* (Isaiah 622; cf. 65:15). The new name which the Lord Himself gave to His followers is found in Acts 11:26 where *"the disciples were called Christians first in Antioch."* Going back to the thoughts of 1 Corinthians 1:10-13, it was Christ who was crucified for us; it was Christ's name into which we were baptized. Therefore, it is Christ's name we must wear, and none other. Let us be CHRIST-ians only, just as His inspired word directs.
