Revive Us Again

Revival is such a beautiful, and biblical word. In the midst of a passage where king David is offering thanksgiving to God for deliverance of the children of Israel in that God had *"forgiven the iniquity of thy people, thou has covered all their sins"* (Psalm 85:2 KJV). He then prayed, *"Wilt thou not revive us again: that thy people may rejoice in thee?"* (Psalm 85:6).

Many Christians need to revive that zeal which accompanied their initial obedience. Some need to revive the desire for biblical knowledge which they once had. The flame that once burned in the soul has become a dying ember and needs to be, yea, must be revived lest *"...the latter end be worse with them than the beginning"* (2 Peter 2:20).

Most congregations of the church of Christ offer convenient times for all people to worship God and study His Holy Word. Sunday morning and mid-week Bible classes, Sunday morning and evening worship services, our ladies' Thursday morning classes, Mail-outs of House to House/Heart to Heart, our Sunday morning radio program, Bible correspondence courses and home Bible studies are all offered with revival in mind.

Another Psalm pleads, *"Create in me a clean heart, O God; and renew a right spirit in me"* (Psalm 51:10). This, too, is calling for the revival of spiritual life! Only the most calused could attend all of the services offered here at Lincoln and not be revived in many ways spiritually.

In the first and last stanzas of one of the great hymns we so often sing has the following praise and petition to our God:

We praise Thee, O God
For the Son of Thy love,
For Jesus who died
And is now gone above.

Revive us again:
Fill each heart with Thy love;
May each heart be rekindled
With fire from above.

Hallelujah! Thine the glory,
Hallelujah! A-men!
Hallelujah! Thine the glory,
Revive us again.

"Wilt thou not revive us again; that thy people may rejoice in thee? Show us thy mercy, O Lord, and grant us thy salvation ... I will hear what God the Lord will speak: for he will speak peace unto his people, and to his saints: but them not turn again to folly"
(Psalm 85:6-8)
